**Title of Training:** Workshop and study visit to the local solid waste management  
**Date:** February 22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012  
**Venue:** Pichit Municipality in Pichit province and Pitsanulok Municipality in Pitsanulok Province

**Number of Participants:** 40 Participants

### Brief description of training aim and content:

The target group of this activity are representatives and community leaders, Chiang Rai Municipal Officers and representative from academia and nearby local governments that join with Chiang Rai Municipality. The aim of the workshop was to encourage sharing and learning from the best practice amongst participants and their own experiences such as how the community generate income from solid waste, how to strengthen community and building people participation, role of local government and solid waste management and role of community and solid waste management etc.

### Outcomes:

After two days of program, participants came up with the following suggestions and discussion points:

- Solid waste management program should run in all communities of the participating local governments; local governments have to work together in the same direction;
- To solve solid waste problem, local governments have to run continuously campaign to building people awareness and people participation in their area;
- In order to overcome solid waste problem, team should be aware of the campaign it's that will launch should suite to that area;
- Identify a person to act as leader and co-operator in communities;
- Local government should act as supporter and let communities run their activities;

**Title of Training:** Knowledge sharing and workshop on the conservative of old market of Pakkret by people participation  
**Date:** January 28<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012  
**Venue:** Takuapa Municipality and Phuket Municipality

**Number of Participants:** 48 Participants

### Brief description of training aim and content:

The target group of this activity are representatives or community leaders of the old market of Pakkret Municipality, as well as municipal clerk, and government agencies in that area. The aim of the workshop was to encourage learning and sharing amongst all stakeholders as well as to strengthen the exchange between the community and Pakkred municipality. From view point of community, participants plan to visit two of old market in Phuket province and Phung Ngaprovince. On municipality side, group also visits office of Phuket Municipality and Takua Pa Municipality to discuss with municipal officers who have been responded. Otherwise representative from Phuket will join in group discussion.

### Outcomes:

After capacity building activity, participants have understood guideline how to develop old market of Pakkret which are:

- Participants have to identify who will be the key contact person in old market;
- Old market has to indentify its own characteristic such as traditional food, local food, local life style, etc.;
- Old market has to do registration as old market of Pakkret group in order to request budget from municipality;
- Old market has to establish network with other community;
- Old market should set up yearly activities plan in order to put on Pakkret yearly calendar.

**Title of Training:** Workshop on capacity building of personnel services to improve the efficiency of public services at the center of Songkhla Municipality

**Date:** February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012

**Venue:** Green World Palace Songkhla Hotel

**Number of Participants:** 60 Participants

**Brief description of training aim and content:**

The training program, Demonstration of using program through Web Application System, was aimed to strengthen the capacities of participants to use the program effectively and to acknowledge the problems, suggestions and recommendations from participants to improve the program perfectly. The program was demonstrated by Mr. Akkachai Wiwanthanaphirak, from King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi. The trial version of Single Window Service through Web Application system has been developed for 3 local public services in 3 sections, (1) Division of Public Health and Environment, (2) Division of Public Works, and (3) Subdivision of Municipal Enterprises Control, Office of Municipality Clerk. The participants were trained to use the program by using example data, and the discussion will be made in order to get problems and suggestion to develop to program effectively. The participants can make comments, even though it is not their responsible, for overall improvement. The details of the program to be demonstrated are as follows:

1. The program of Division of Public Health and Environment is designed to provide license permit, fee payment for business enterprises related to foods, and all activities that are harmful for life.
2. The program of Division of Public Works is designed to provide license permit for building construction. By using this program, both officers and applicants, who ask for building permit, can follow up every steps of the permit process. This program can be used by many people in the same time. It means both officer and applicant can communicate though the system.
3. The program of Subdivision of Municipal Enterprises Control, Office of Municipality Clerk, is designed to provide the registration of new business enterprises, including the change and the cancellation of business enterprises. At the first phase, the program can be used only for the new registers, not for the old ones who already registered on paper-based.

**Outcomes:**

After workshop, participants realize that their mission is to serve the people both reactive and proactive. E-government is one of tools that very useful. Municipal clerks understand Web Application the degree of confidence in its use. They also recommend including suggestions for training.

7. The executives have acknowledged the progress of the project.
8. Participants come with their plan to initiate the training by dividing themselves in to group by job characteristic. After that choose the leader of group to work as trainer and coach of their group

**Title of Training:** Knowledge sharing and workshop on public service management by community and people participation

**Date:** February 11<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>, 2012

**Venue:** Hatyai Paradise & Resort Hotel, Songkla Province

**Number of Participants:** 109 Participants

**Brief description of training aim and content:**

The target group of this activity were representatives or leaders of communities in Yala Municipal area. Workshop's program wants the participants realize that they themselves are main actors and the key to the success in developing their own communities. In order to achieve the goal, Municipality invites the representative or leader, communities from best practice municipality and other successful communities, to present and discuss their experiences. People participation is one of issue that participants have to discuss among them. In part of municipality, Municipal clerks who will be response and cooperate activities that will be run in the future. They have to understand what community want and how municipality can support them.

**Outcomes:**

On the first day, the workshop started with the introduction of the DELGOSEA Network and the concept of good governance by focusing on people participation. After that, discussion on street vendor management by community in Songkhla Municipality and on integrated development of waterworks services through community Involvement in Yala Municipality area. Participants understood objectives of DelgoSEA and interested in how communities will be involved in the integrated development of waterworks services through community Involvement in Yala Municipality area. But they still questions about how municipality can support them.

On second day, representative from KhonKaen Municipality discussed and shared their experience on small municipality in big municipality. Most questions that communities leader from Yala asked representative from
