Policy Makers and Civil Society in Southeast Asia discuss Replication of Best Practices in Local Governance

Indonesian policy makers and civil society came together today (17/4) in Jakarta to discuss best practice replication in local governance. The event is part of a series of workshop organised by DELGOSEA – a regional project supporting best practice exchange in local governance. The workshops in Bangkok (Thailand) and Hanoi (Vietnam) will be conducted on 19 and 27 April, respectively. In Manila (The Philippines), the workshop was held on 29 March 2012.

Focus of the discussion in Jakarta was on the outcomes of the replication process in four pilot cities: Kupang, Tarakan, Pangkal Pinang and Wakatobi. The draft policy recommendations was finalised during the workshop, as well as a roadmap on advocacy for the implementation of these policy recommendations.

The development of a strategy for sustainability of the best practice transfer, DELGOSEA website and secretariat were other important topics on the agenda to ensure continuous transnational platform for knowledge and information exchange within Southeast Asia.

“DELGOSEA supports exchange of expertise and best practice among partners. The workshop will strengthen the cooperation and network among key stakeholders such as Local Government Associations (LGAs), policy makers and civil society in creating policy recommendations that will be an important guideline for further best practice replication or expansion in the future”, said Ms. Natalis Padang, DELGOSEA National Coordinator for Indonesia.

Participants in the workshop included policy makers and strategic partners of the DELGOSEA network: LGAs, representatives of the pilot cities, civil society organisations, academia and media, as well as the Delegation of the European Union.
